Dear Year 6 Students & Families

We would like to invite you to join our Learn to Row program in Term 4.

Rowing is a fantastic activity that involves the usage of almost every muscle in our body. You'll learn new skills, enjoy supportive coaching, and make lasting friendships in a positive team environment.

Many of our Learn to Row participants have gone on to compete in the summer season, with several achieving medals in the Year 7/8 category at the Head of the River. We would love to see you give rowing a try!

The Learn to Row Course will commence in Term 4, Week 2 and it will run for 6 weeks as outlined below:

- Week 2 and Week 3: 1 session per week in the senior school, Tuesday 3:45pm to 5:00pm
- Week 4 and Week 5: 2 sessions per week in the senior school, Tuesday & Thursday 3:45pm to 5:00pm
- Week 6 and Week 7: 1 session per week in the senior school, Tuesday 3:45pm to 5:00pm, and 1 session per week at West Lakes, Thursday 3:30pm to 7:30pm.

All rowers will be transported to and from the lake. The cost for this LTR program is \$220. Any costs following this program will align with the rowing fees shared in the handbook.

At the completion of the course, participants will be invited to join the Junior Rowing Squad. Those who choose to continue will have the opportunity to attend training sessions during the January holidays, including a squad training day on 19 January 2027.
